I. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Every student of this college shall adhere to the dress code prescribed by the management. The only formal dress will be permitted. Jeans and T-Shirts will not be permitted. All boys will wear shoes on all days. An overcoat is to be worn over the regular dress during the practical sessions.
- All students should always wear Identity Cards inside the Campus.
- Students are expected to put up 100% attendance. However, under Anna University norms, a student has to put up a minimum of 75% of attendance, failing which, he/she will not be permitted to write the end semester examinations.
- Students shall not absent themselves from classes without proper leave application. Application for leave in the prescribed format shall be submitted personally to the concerned HOD for prior permission.
- Permission to leave the college premises during working hours can be granted only by the Principal, recommended by the concerned HOD, on the production of a letter of request from the Student/ Parent/ Guardian.
- A medical certificate should be produced for more than 3 days of sick leave to be approved by the Principal.
- Attendance for Unit Tests and Model Examinations is compulsory.
- Cell phones should be kept switched off in the class Room/ Laboratory. If this rule is violated, the cell phone will be confiscated.
- Do not throw papers or spill/ splash ink on the floor/ corridors/ Staircase. Put all the waste materials in the dustbin.
- No meeting of any kind shall be conducted without permission from the Principal.
- Students should not collect money for any purpose without permission from the Principal.
- No notice of any kind shall be circulated by students/ pasted anywhere on the college campus without prior permission by the Principal.
- No student shall take part in any political activity.
- Students are responsible for the safety of their personal belongings. For any loss of property, the management will not take responsibility.
- Students should make it a habit to read the Notice/ Circular and other papers displayed on the Notice boards and take appropriate action as directed therein.
- Any property/ articles found on the premises must be handed over to the office with relevant details.

- Change of address for communication should be intimated to the class advisor immediately.
- Ragging is a cognizable offense, and the accused is liable to be arrested and imprisoned in addition to being dismissed from the college.
- Students should not enter the college in an inebriated condition, failing which they will be removed from the college and they will not be allowed inside the college campus, so that it will be a deterrent to the students.
- Smoking as well as consuming any form of intoxicants is strictly prohibited.
- Self-discipline is expected from the students, at all common places like laboratories, classrooms, library, playground, canteen, common functions, etc., failing which disciplinary action will be taken.
- Students have to make good to the Institution when called upon to do so, any damage caused to apparatus, furniture, or any other articles, due to their negligence or arrogance.
- Failure on the part of the students to follow disciplinary rules will result in disciplinary action including expulsion from the Institution/ Hostel as may be imposed by the Principal/ Management.
- The decision of the Principal/ Management concerning disciplinary action shall be FINAL and all the students shall abide by such decisions.

II. SCHOLARSHIP

SC/ST/SCC SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility

Students of First year B.E./B.Tech /B.Arch/MBA / M.E. are eligible for applying for Tamil Nadu State Government SC/ST/SCC Scholarship if he /she belongs to SC/ST/SCC community and the income of the parents is limited to Rs.2,50,000/- for SC/ST Students and Rs.2,00,000/- for BC Converted Christian Adi Dravida (SCC)).

The students who wish to avail the scholarship should collect the application form from the respective class advisor and submit the filled-up application form to the class advisor along with the following documents.

1. Parents' Income Certificate (in ORIGINAL) for the current financial year
2. Photocopy of Student's Bank Passbook (Active Account) with Aadhaar Linked
3. Attendance Certificate obtained from Last studied School (in ORIGINAL)

4. Photocopy of DOTE Allotment Order / Consortium order
5. Photocopy of 10th & 12th Marksheets
6. Photocopy of Community Certificate
7. Photocopy of Aadhaar Number
8. Passport Size Photo – 2 Copies
9. Photocopy of First Graduate Certificate (if applicable)

The scholarship application is to be submitted online to the Department of Adi-Dravida and Tribal Welfare by the college.

BC/MBC SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility

Students of First year B.E./B.Tech /B.Arch/MBA / M.E. are eligible for applying for Tamil Nadu State Government BC/MBC Scholarship if he /she belongs to BC/MBC community and the income of the parents is limited to Rs.2,00,000/- per annum.

The students who wish to avail the scholarship should collect the application form from the respective class advisor and submit the filled-up application form to the class advisor along with the following documents.

1. Parents' Income Certificate (in ORIGINAL) for the current financial year
2. Photocopy of Student's Bank Passbook (Active Account) with Aadhaar Linked
3. Attendance Certificate obtained from Last studied School (in ORIGINAL)
4. Photocopy of DOTE Allotment Order
5. Photocopy of 10th & 12th Marksheets
6. Photocopy of Community Certificate
7. Photocopy of Aadhaar Number
8. Photocopy of First Graduate Certificate (if applicable)

The scholarship application is to be submitted online to the Department of Backward Classes Welfare by the college.

PRAGATI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR GIRL STUDENTS.

Eligibility

1. Up to Two Girls per family.
2. Family income should be less than Rs. 8 Lakhs per Annum.
3. Students admitted for Diploma/Undergraduate Degree Level Programmes / Courses in AICTE Approved Institutions.
4. Students admitted in 1st year through the centralized admission process in AICTE approved Technical Institution for approved Diploma/Degree level Programmes

Amount of Scholarship/annum /student: Rs. 30,000/- (or) the actual tuition fees paid, whichever is less.

To apply for the above scholarship, Log on to [www. aicte-pragati-saksham-gov. in](http://www.aicte-pragati-saksham-gov.in) & apply for Online Registration and follow the instructions.

SAKSHAM SCHOLARSHIP FOR DIFFERENTLY-ABLED STUDENTS

Eligibility

1. Only for Differently Abled Students having more than 40% disability.
2. Family income should be less than Rs. 8 lakhs per Annum.
3. Students Admitted for Diploma/Undergraduate Degree Level Programmes /Courses in AICTE Approved Institutions
4. Students admitted in 1st year through the centralized admission process in AICTE approved Technical Institution for approved Diploma/Degree level Programmes

Amount of Scholarship/annum /student: Rs. 30,000/- (or) the actual tuition fees paid, whichever is less

POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

Eligibility

1. Students belonging to notified minority communities viz. Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain, Parsi (Zoroastrian) studying in India only and fulfilling the Scheme guidelines.
2. The scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.
3. The award will be discontinued if a student fails to secure 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination. The scholarship will not be awarded for more than the normal period taken to obtain a Degree.
4. Scholarships will not be given to more than two students in a family.
5. Course fee/tuition fee and maintenance allowance will be credited directly to the student's bank account.
6. The student obtaining benefits under this scholarship scheme shall not be allowed to avail of benefits under any other scholarship scheme implemented by State Government/UT Administration, for the same purpose.

7. Renewal - The scholarship, once awarded, may be renewed during the next academic year of the course on the production of a certificate that the student has secured 50% marks in the examination.

The scheme is implemented through National Scholarship Portal (NSP). All students must apply online on the website - www.scholarships.gov.in

MERIT CUM MEANS BASED SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

Eligibility

1. Students belonging to notified minority communities viz. Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain, Parsi (Zoroastrian) studying in India only and fulfilling the Scheme guidelines.
2. Students who get admission in technical/professional courses without taking any competitive examination will also be eligible for the scholarship. However, such students should have not secured less than 50% marks at higher secondary/graduation level.
3. The annual income of the beneficiary/parent or guardian of the beneficiary should not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh from all sources.
4. Continuation of the scholarship in subsequent years will depend on the successful completion of the course during the preceding year.
5. A scholarship holder under this scheme will not avail any other Scholarship /stipend for pursuing the course.
6. Course fee/tuition fee and maintenance allowance will be credited directly to the student's bank account.
7. The annual income of the beneficiary/parent or guardian of the beneficiary should not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh from all sources.
8. Renewal - The scholarship, once awarded, may be renewed during the next academic year of the course on the production of a certificate that the student has secured 50% marks in the examination.

The scheme is implemented through National Scholarship Portal (NSP). All students must apply online on the website - www.scholarships.gov.in

III.PROCEDURE FOR RECEIVING CERTIFICATES FROM COLLEGE OFFICE

BONAFIDE CERTIFICATE

Bonafide Certificates will be issued to students for applying for a bank loan, passport, private scholarship, etc., on request using the prescribed application form. The application form can be obtained from the class advisors and filled-up application forms with necessary documents are to be submitted to class advisors. After two days, the certificates can be obtained from class advisors.

RAILWAY CONCESSION

Students can obtain the railway concession form from the College office by forming a group (Minimum of 4 or 5 students) for the same destination and the filled-up form can be submitted by a representative from the group. After two days, all the students of the team should come to the college office for signing in the form and collect the concession form.

COURSE COMPLETION CERTIFICATE

Final Year students who have cleared all the dues while receiving the hall ticket, can collect their course completion certificates after the last examination of the final semester from their respective class advisors.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE, FINAL SEMESTER MARK SHEETS, AND PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE

Students can collect their no dues form from Certificate Section, get the acknowledgment of clearing all the dues, and submit the same to Certificate Section. After verifying the records, the Transfer Certificate will be prepared, verified by the concerned student and the Transfer Certificate signed by the Principal will be handed over to the student after obtaining his/her signature in the Certificate Issue Register.

IV. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING RAGGING

The students of this institution are hereby informed that "Ragging" in any form is strictly prohibited. It is needless to explain the harassment, humiliation, and sufferings to which the new entrants would be subjected in the name of "Ragging" which is inhuman and intolerable. "Ragging" means displaying of noisy, disorderly condition or doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raises apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student and includes: teasing abusing of, playing practical jokes, or causing hurt to such students or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such students will not in the ordinary course do. The management will enforce strict discipline among the students of the college and very much wishes that the college should be a model institution free from ragging. The students are therefore strictly warned to refrain from involving in any ragging activity. Those who involve in ragging, in any form shall be expelled immediately from the college and Hostel, and they are liable to punishment as per UGC regulations.

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates "Ragging" within or outside the institution, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term as decided by the court and shall also be liable to a fine.

V. RULES FOR HOSTEL STUDENTS

All inmates of the Hostel shall observe the following rules for the smooth and efficient running of the hostel to ensure a comfortable stay.

- Only bonafide students of St. Peter's College of Engineering and Technology are eligible for admission to the hostel.
- Ragging is a cognizable offense, and the accused is liable to be arrested and imprisoned in addition to being dismissed from the college. All the inmates are advised and strictly warned not to indulge in any sort of ragging.

- Inmates should not change the rooms allotted to them without the permission of the Principal/ Warden.
- No posters or pictures should be stuck inside and outside the rooms or anywhere in and around the premises of the Hostel and College.
- Inmates shall be responsible for proper and careful use of furniture and fixtures provided in the rooms and hostel premises.
- Inmates should not remove any furniture from the rooms and no extra furniture can be brought in from outside.
- Tampering with fixtures and electrical connections is strictly forbidden.
- No damage to any property of the institution should be caused by any student. The cost of such damage will be recovered along with a fine from the inmates.
- Inmates shall switch off fans and lights before leaving their rooms.
- No guests and no day-scholars are permitted to stay in the hostel rooms.
- The audio set should not be used. If the rule is violated, the set will be confiscated and will be returned to the students only after the completion of the course.
- The inmates are advised to close the water taps after use to avoid wastage of water.
- Inmates shall take their food in the mess and there will be no room service.
- Girl Hostellers are not allowed to leave or enter the hostel after 6.00 p.m. The time for boys is 7.00.p.m.
- All rooms, corridors, toilets, etc., must be kept clean and any student who violates the rule shall be expelled from the hostel.
- Inmates shall keep their area noise-free.
- All complaints regarding the toilet, water, and power supply should be made to the Resident Warden in writing.
- Visitors shall be allowed only between 4.00p.m to 6.00 p.m. to the Hostel.
- Silence hour will be observed from 8.30 pm onwards.
- Food will be served in the mess only during the mess timings displayed on the notice board. Inmates coming late to the mess after the mess timings, food will not be served.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages, drugs, and smoking inside the Hostel premises is strictly prohibited. If violated, the students will be expelled from the hostel and the college also, if necessary.
- Students must report for the roll-call regularly
- Those who are not complying with the above-mentioned rules shall be liable for such punishment like fine/ expulsion as may be imposed by the Principal/ Management
