- **Residential facilities for faculty and non-teaching :**

44 rooms of single accommodation with attached toilets are available for research scholars. Further, 6 staff quarters with 3 bedroom facilities are available in the campus.

- **Cafeteria :**

There is a cafeteria available in the campus in which breakfast and lunch are provided to the day scholars and the faculty. Further, there are 4 kiosks like Coffee day and other vendors.

- **Health centre** – Nature of facilities available – inpatient, outpatient, ambulance, emergency care facility, etc.

A primary health centre has been established in the campus. Spacious room with good light and ventilation is located in the ground floor of the main building. One male doctor and a female doctor along with 2 nursing assistants are available in the centre. A medicine rack with full stock of medicinal facilities is available for first aid management of injuries and minor ailments. Four beds are provided in the centre. The equipments available in the centre are Thermometer, Stethoscope, BP apparatus, Tuning fork,

Ophthalmoscope, Echo Cardiogram, Electro Encephalogram, Patient Monitoring System, Saline stand, Pulse Oxymeter, wheel chair and Stretcher. An ambulance to take the patients to the nearby multi speciality hospital is available at all times.

- **Facilities like banking, post office, book shops, etc.**

A separate Bank building is provided in the campus. A full fledged Indian Bank with Net banking facility is available in the campus which caters to the needs of the faculty and students. Further, an Automated Teller machine (ATM) is also available in the campus.

- **Transport facilities to cater to the needs of the students and staff:**

Bus facilities are available in the campus to transport students to various parts of the city. There are 16 buses, which ply to different parts. Further, one mini bus and seven light motor vehicles are available for the use of the faculty. A separate water tanker is available for supply of potable drinking water to the campus.

- **Facilities for persons with disabilities:** Ramps have been provided in all buildings. A provision for lift has also been provided.

Regular power supply with transformer is available. Further, a Generator of 320 KVA and 3 numbers of 125 KVA are available in the campus for sustaining the power during shut downs.

- **Waste management facility :**

Old answer scripts are sent to paper mills for recycling as it involves confidentiality. Food and kitchen waste is converted into manure. Paper waste and e waste is disposed off through vendors. Sewage treatment plant is available in the hostels. Usage of plastics is prohibited in the university campus. The cafeteria and the kiosks in the campus use only paper cups. The biological wastes and chemical wastes are carefully disposed without harming the environment of the campus.
