➤ **About SPIHER**

St. Peter's Institute of Higher Education and Research is a deemed to be University located at Avadi in the Chennai Metropolitan City. It was established as a self-financing engineering college in 1993 in the name of St.Peter's Engineering College and was instrumental in the development of Annanur as an Educational town in Avadi Taluk. After attaining deemed University status in 2008, the institution has been focusing on academic excellence, internationalisation, research and innovation. The institution offers undergraduate and postgraduate programs in engineering, technology, management studies, architecture, science and humanities besides M.Phil. and Ph.D. programs. For encouraging innovation and entrepreneurship development, a *Technology Business Incubator* sponsored by the Department of Science and Technology, Ministry of Science and Technology, and *SPIHER – MSME Business Incubator*, sponsored by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India, have been established within the campus. The Institute is certified for ISO 9001-2015 quality system and was previously accredited by NAAC in 2023 with A+ Grade (CGPA 3.28).

The campus is located in a serene environment in a sprawling campus of 32.26 acres. The campus is easily commutable by bus and train. Annanur railway station, on the Chennai Central – Tiruvallur broad gauge section is just 1.5 km from the Institute. The domestic and international airports are located at about 25 kms from the campus. Transport is available from different parts of the city for the benefit of the students. Separate hostel facilities are available for boys and girls and residential accommodation is available for staff members. Guest House for visiting faculty and dignitaries is also available.

Hence there is an opportunity to interact with various small scale entrepreneurs, Industrialists for more collaborative activities. Challenges are enhancing the quality of rural area students and improving their communication, soft skills to face the competitive examinations in a confidence manner. Improvement in National and international ranking would help the Institution for a better visibility and student intake.





Dr. S. Gunasekaran, TANS Awardee

Dean, Research & Development

Dr. S. Gunasekaran was born on 3rd June 1954 in Kathiyavadi Village, Ranipet District. He had completed his B.Sc. in Physics in Tamil Medium from Presidency College, Chennai, M.Sc. in Physics from St. Joseph's college, Tiruchirapalli. He went on to complete his Ph.D. in Molecular Spectroscopy from Anna University and obtained his D.Sc. from University of Madras. **Dr. S. Gunasekaran, Dean (R&D) of St. Peter's Institute of Higher Education and Research, Avadi, Chennai**, began his teaching career at the Pachaiyappa's College, Chennai, in 1978 and remains a dedicated Teacher to this day, his forte being Electronics and Microprocessors. But **Dr. Gunasekaran was restless to do more, than just teach a syllabus, so he went about promoting** research activities in the department by garnering funds to equip the Laboratory with instruments for research. As Dean (R&D), he took support from the Management of St. Peter's Institute of Higher Education & Research and he has established **Sophisticated Analytical Instrumentation Facility (SAIF-SPIHER), housed with advanced spectrophotometers. His area of Research is the Application of Spectroscopy in varied fields that are likely to yield results beneficial to society, like Materials Science, Medical Physics, Environmental Science and Molecular Dynamics.** In fact, recognizing the powerful tool that Spectroscopy can be in Physics research, **Dr. Gunasekaran has coined the term – 'Spectrophysics'.** Till date, **Dr. Gunasekaran has successfully guided 82 candidates who have obtained their Ph.D. in Materials Science, Medical Physics, Environmental Science and Molecular Dynamics.** He has to his credit, more than **430 publications in reputed journals and has h-index as 42 and i10-index as 185 with 7787 citations.** He has published **1 patent** so far. **He is also extending his meritorious service of being referee of many reputed journal.**

Dr. S. Gunasekaran is the **Founder, President of INDIAN SPECTROPHYSICS ASSOCIATION – (ISPA)** Started on April 23, 1998. It is the peak of a strong belief that enlightening minds and empowering them through Spectroscopy and Physical Phenomena is way for battling and eliminating social evils and uplifting the society. Indian Spectrophysics Association (ISPA) through its initiatives provides access not only for quality education in spectroscopy and its applications, enhance innovative researches, but also inculcates values, commitment and dedication to the society, thus helping to build a strong future for every researcher like a Spectrum of Physics.

Indian Spectrophysics Association (ISPA) is privileged to honor the notable services of the Spectrophysicists with **Life Time Achievement Award**, the award is conferred to whom those who dedicated themselves in the spectroscopy research and still working on the respective fields to enrich the society with their findings. For young researchers who have made excellent contributions in the field of Research, made to benefit of humanity have been honoured with **ISPA Dr. S. Gunasekaran Award** during Conferences/Seminars organized by ISPA. ISPA has organised 20 international, 18 national and 16 state level conferences, seminars, workshops had been organized by the Indian SpectroPhysics Association (ISPA) so far. ISPA has the honour of giving 13 **Veteran Scientists Award**, 42 **Life Time Achievement Award**, 81 **ISPA Dr. S. Gunasekaran Award** so far.

Dr. Gunasekaran has also rendered great service to the School Education Board of the Government of Tamil Nadu, by serving as a Member of the Syllabus Revision Committee and Chairperson of Book writing committee. He has authored 14 books for Higher Secondary Physics, Secondary Science and Environmental Education, in both Tamil and English medium.

Dr. Gunasekaran has been featured in the list of “World Ranking of Top 2% Scientists in 2021“, published by Stanford University under the category of “Chemical Physics/ General Chemistry/ Physics & Astronomy“. More recently, **Dr. Gunasekaran** is honoured with five prestigious Awards viz., Tamil Nadu Scientist Award, ISPA Dr. S. Mohan Life Time Achievement Award, Eminent Educationist Award, Best Citizen of India Gold Medal Award and Indo Global Research Excellence Award by Government of Tamil Nadu and various reputed organizations. He is conferred with **Life Time Achievement Award** by National College, Tiruchirapalli in February 2019, **Life Time Achievement Award** by University of Madras in April 2018 and **Life Time Achievement Award** by AMET University in March 2018. In September 2016, he is conferred with **Award for Research Excellence by Indus Valley Foundation**, USA. In August 2016, he is bestowed with **Bharath Ratna Rajiv Gandhi Gold Medal Award** for his participation and contribution to research and society by Global Economic Progress and Research Association. **Dr.**

Gunasekaran has bestowed with Ariviyal Kalanjiyam Award 2015 by Mayilai Thiruvalluvar Tamil Sangam, Chennai. He has obtained Best Physics Student Award during the course at St. Joseph's College, Trichy. Many awards have been conferred on Dr. Gunasekaran in the light of his dedicated service to Teaching and Research, to mention a few, Award For Excellence in the Spheres of Academic, Research and administration in August 2013 by Sri Vidya Mandir Arts and Science College, Uthangarai, Tamil Nadu. He is awarded for his achievement in the field of Higher Education by St. Joseph's College in Josephites Re Union 2013, Trichy. Dr. Gunasekaran was conferred with Life Time Achievement Award during National Conference on Recent Advances in Applied Sciences (NCRAAS 2012). Dr. Gunasekaran is awarded with "Best Teacher Award" by Lion's Club International and Pachaiyappa's College, Chennai. He was conferred on "Eminent Scientist Award" in 2010 by Sree Kanchi Kamakodi Peetam, for his outstanding contribution to Science and Technology. He is awarded with "Research Guide Achievement Award" for his outstanding research in the field of Spectroscopy; the "Psychometric Educational Services Award" by The GCC School of Creative Intelligence and Research Foundation Trust for his valuable services and contributions to Human Resource Development; a "Certificate of Appreciation" for the successful conduct of the unique technical seminars for PG and M.Phil. students at the X State Level Technical Seminar in Physical Sciences in 2008; a "Certificate of Appreciation" by the Journal Spectrochimica Acta in 2007.

It is very evident, that from humble beginnings, **Dr. Gunasekaran has come a long way, achieving all that he has, and if he stands tall today, it is only through sheer dint of hard work, honesty, sincerity, perseverance and self-confidence. As a result, his panoramic insight in the research has brought him a prestigious Tamil Nadu Scientist Award (TANSA) in Physical Sciences for the year 2013.**

Dr. M. Palaniswamy, Dean, Planning, Development and Accreditation

Dr. M. Palaniswamy, Dean, Planning, Development and Accreditation, St. Peter's Institute of Higher Education and Research (SPIHER), Deemed to be University, Chennai is a learned personality, revered for his nature of simplicity and for his academic accomplishments. He obtained his Doctorate in Biotechnology from Bharathiar University, Coimbatore in 1998. He began his career as a Lecturer and Head at RVS College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore in the Department of Microbiology in 1998. Then he worked at Karpagam Arts and Science College, Coimbatore from 2002 as Senior Lecturer and Head and Founder Department of Microbiology. He was then promoted as the Head of the Department of Microbiology, Karpagam Academy of Higher Education (Deemed to be University) in the year 2008. His tenure as the Head of the Department of Microbiology lasted till the year 2014 until his promotion as Dean, Faculty of Arts Science and Humanities at Karpagam Academy of Higher Education, Coimbatore. He served as Dean for a period of five years from 2014 to 2019. He has served as Registrar at Karpagam Academy of Higher Education, Coimbatore from 2020 to 2022. He is also entrusted with the critical tasks of preparing documents for NIRF, NAAC, and AISHE by the Karpagam Academy of Higher Education. He has 25 years of Teaching experience and 30 years of Research experience in the domain of Biotechnology. His credentials include publication of 143 research papers in reputed journals. To his credit, he has filed seven patents so far. He undertook and completed five major research projects funded by UGC, DST, DBT and SERB. He has successfully guided 20 scholars towards their PhD.



The library management system is fully computerized with AUTOLIB software which is fully automated, Version 5.1 and the year of automation being 2000. On-line Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) facilities are available. These OPAC terminals are user-friendly and informative. OPAC has features such as fast book identifier, location identification of the books in the Library stack area, List of all available books of an author and the borrower's status etc. The library has rich collection of more than 91,325 volume of books, journals, thesis, back volumes and non-book materials etc. It has 10827 e-Books collections from DELNET, National Digital Library, World e-Books Library, and Rare Book Society of India. The Institute has subscribed to various e-journals, 298 from IEEE, ASME, ASCE and 1897 from DELNET. In addition, the Library has Institutional

membership with INFLIBNET, e-Shodh Sindhu, Shodh Ganga, British Council, American Library, CSIR-SERC Library that provide enhanced access to online resources. The research scholars, students and faculty members get benefitted by these resources available in the Central Library. A full-fledged Digital Library is functioning with 25 computers. All the subscribed e-resources like Databases, e-journals and e-books can be accessed. Local and remote access of software like Grammarly, INFED and Ezproxy help the users on a 24/7 basis by adopting virtual learning environment. Remote access to the library is also available through the ERP portal which can be accessed by the students and faculty. Access to online resources provides a conducive environment for the students to take up NPTEL and MOOC courses.

The library has extended a wide range of services for learners like Search Alert service, Domain Specific User Orientation, Circulation services, Reference Services, Reprography Services, Reservation, On-line Question Bank, Inter Library Loan and Scanning / Printing Service. The library uses Anti plagiarism web tool “DrillBit” which is used to check the plagiarism in theses and research papers of students, research scholars and faculty members. The requirement and list of books are taken from the concerned departments and HODs are involved in the process. The finalized list of required books is duly approved by the Registrar.
